Beginning at an iron pipe at the Northeast corner of this lot, the Northwest corner of Lot 1111 and on the Southeast side of "Road A", the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 20686.4 feet South and 10840.6 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2650, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 355° 40' 1540.0 feet along Lots 1111 and 1211 to an iron pin in bottom of gulch;
2. 85° 40' 968.0 feet along Lot 1212 to an iron pipe;
3. 175° 40' 1135.7 feet along Lot 1113 to an iron pipe;
4. 243° 00' 1049.0 feet along the Southeast side of "Road A" to the point of beginning.
