- Beginning at "X" marked on stone on the East side of 30 Foot Homestead Road and between this lot and Lot 10, the true azimuth and distance from said marked stone to Government Survey Trig. Station "Rocky Hollow" being $124^{\circ} 42'$ 681.4 feet, and the true azimuth to Government Survey Trig. Station "Paina 2" is $21^{\circ} 30'$, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2293, and running by true azimuths:-
1. $130^{\circ} 00'$ 701.5 feet across Homestead Road passing over rock marked "X" in Waiomao Stream, along Lot 10 and up pali to top of ridge between Waiomao and the land of Kekio; from this point the true azimuth and distance to "Rocky Hollow" Trig. Station is $20^{\circ} 00'$ 67.0 feet;
 2. $210^{\circ} 52'$ 516.5 feet along top of ridge between Waiomao and Kekio;
 3. $310^{\circ} 00'$ 2698.0 feet along Lot 12, down pali, passing over rock marked "XI" in Waiomao Stream, across road, and up pali to top of ridge between Waiomao and Waialae Nui, from which point the true azimuth and distance to "Pia" Trig. Station (marked by \triangle on set stone) is $211^{\circ} 56'$ 182.5 feet;
 4. Thence along top of ridge between Waiomao and Waialae Nui, the direct azimuth and distance being: $27^{\circ} 15'$ 522.5 ft.;
 5. $130^{\circ} 00'$ 2030.0 feet down pali along Lot 10 to the point of beginning.

Excepting and reserving therefrom that portion of the 30 Foot Homestead Road (0.40 acre) within this lot, leaving a net area of 31.3 ACRES.
