KANIAHIKU HOUSE LOTS EXTENSION

Kaniahiku, Puna, Hawaii, T. H.


Being portion of the Government Land of Kaniahiku.

Beginning at a $\frac{3}{4}$ inch pipe at the northeast corner of this lot, the northwest corner of Lot 10, Kaniahiku House Lots Extension and on the south side of 50-Foot Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "PAHOA" being 3493.71 feet South and 8147.04 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered H.T.S. Plat 816-A, thence running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1. 16° 30' 509.49 feet along Lot 10, Kaniahiku House Lots Extension to a pipe in concrete;
2. 106° 30' 256.49 feet along Grant 12614 to ~~Asayo~~ Kuraya (Lot 6, Kaniahiku House Lots) to a pipe in concrete;
3. 196° 30' 509.49 feet along Lot 12, Kaniahiku House Lots Extension to a $\frac{3}{4}$ inch pipe;
4. 286° 30' 256.49 feet along the south side of 50-Foot Road to the point of beginning and containing an Area of 3.00 Acres.
