

Beginning at an iron pipe at the West corner of this lot and the South corner of Lot 11, Block 401, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 7020.5 feet South and 9752.1 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 238° 10' 484.0 feet along Lot 11, Block 401, to an iron pipe;
2. 328° 10' 482.5 feet along government land to an iron pipe;
3. 355° 40' 662.5 feet along government land to an iron pipe;
4. 85° 40' 484.0 feet along the North side of "Road ⁸X" to an iron pipe;
5. 175° 40' 180.0 feet along Lot 1, Block 401, to an iron pipe;
6. 171° 05' 237.8 feet along Lot 2, Block 401, to an iron pipe;
7. 161° 55' 237.8 feet along Lot 3, Block 401, to an iron pipe;
8. 152° 45' 237.8 feet along Lot 4, Block 401, to the point of beginning.
