Beginning at an iron pipe at the Northeast corner of this lot, the East corner of Lot 1101, on the West side of "Road 4 West", the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 20096.2 feet South and 1550.4 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2650, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $128^{\circ} 45'$ 43.0 feet along the West side of "Road 4 West" to a stake;
2. $333^{\circ} 25'$ 388.2 feet along same to a stake;
3. $335^{\circ} 56'$ 262.3 feet along same to an iron pin;
4. $48^{\circ} 59'$ 2195.5 feet along government land to an iron pin;
5. $175^{\circ} 40'$ 1955.9 feet along Lots 1302 and 1202 to an iron pipe;
6. $265^{\circ} 40'$ 1505.4 feet along Lot 1101 to the point of beginning.

AREA 50-75/100 ACRES.

Excepting and reserving therefrom the Government Survey Trig. Station "Young 1" and a lot 50 feet square surrounding same, (Area 06/100 Acre), together with the right to enter upon said lot and to occupy said Trig. Station, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 50-69/100 ACRES.
