Beginning at an iron pipe at the Southwest corner of this lot, the Northwest corner of Lot 1310 and on the East side of "Road 8 West", the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 22788.4 feet South and 8700.3 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2650, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 175° 40' 810.0 feet along the East side of "Road 8 West" to an iron pipe;
2. 265° 40' 1627.1 feet along Lot 1209-B to an iron pipe;
3. 355° 40' 810.0 feet along Lot 1208 to an iron pipe;
4. 85° 40' 1627.1 feet along Lot 1310 to the point of beginning.

AREA 30-25/100 ACRES.

Excepting and reserving therefrom the Government Survey Trig. Station "Clark" and a lot 50 feet square surrounding same, (Area 06/100 Acre), together with the right to enter upon said lot and to occupy said Trig. Station.

Also, excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 20 feet wide for the railroad across this lot, said right-of-way containing an Area of 35/100 Acre,
