

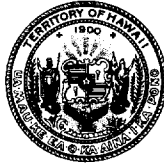

Beginning at a spike at the Northwest corner of this lot, the Southwest corner of Lot 121, and on the East side of Wilder Road (30 feet wide), the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kaumana" being 638.81 feet South and 3382.77 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map 2922, and running by azimuths measured clockwise from true South:-

1. 270° 21' 128.84 feet along Lot 121, Kaumana House Lots, to a spike;
2. 360° 00' 109.97 feet along Lot 120, Kaumana House Lots, to a spike;
3. 103° 49' 28.99 feet along Grant 4074 to H. C. Hitchcock to a spike;
4. 78° 27' 175.00 feet along same to a spike;
5. 207° 00' 155.87 feet along the East side of Wilder Road to the point of beginning.
