1. 329° 31' 653.4 feet along Lot 12 to a post;
2. 59° 31' 200.0 feet along Lot 2 to a post;
3. 149° 31' 653.4 feet along Lot 14 to a post on the South side of Keonelehua Avenue;
4. 239° 31' 200.0 feet along Keonelehua Avenue to the point of beginning.
