Beginning at a spike set in concrete at the Northeast corner of this lot, the Northwest corner of Lot 10, and on the South side of road (30 feet wide), the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kaneahue" being 1687.6 feet North and 672.8 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2813, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 352° 07' 103.5 feet along Lot 10, to a spike set in concrete;
2. 78° 12' 80.2 feet along Government Land to a spike set in concrete;
3. 172° 07' 109.0 feet along East side of road (30 feet wide), to a spike set in concrete;
4. 262° 07' 80.0 feet along road (30 feet wide), to the point of beginning.
