Kaniahiku, Puna, Hawaii, T. H.


Being portion of the Government Land of Kaniahiku.

Beginning at a $\frac{3}{4}$ inch pipe at the northeast corner of this lot, the northwest corner of Lot 12, Kaniahiku House Lots Extension and on the south side of 50-Foot Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "PAHOA" being 3348.01 feet South and 7655.18 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered H.T.S. Plat 816-A, thence running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1. $16^{\circ} 30'$ 509.49 feet along Lot 12, Kaniahiku House Lots Extension to a spike;
2. $106^{\circ} 30'$ 246.49 feet along Grant 10999 to Minoru Miyatake (Lot 4, Kaniahiku House Lots) to a $\frac{3}{4}$ inch pipe;
3. $196^{\circ} 30'$ 459.49 feet along the east side of 50-Foot Road to a spike;
4. Thence on a curve to the right having a radius of 50.00 feet, the chord azimuth and distance being: $241^{\circ} 30' 70.71$ feet to a $\frac{3}{4}$ inch pipe;
5. $286^{\circ} 30'$ 196.49 feet along the south side of 50-Foot Road to the point of beginning and containing an Area of 2.871 Acres.
