Beginning at an iron pipe at the Northeast corner of this lot, the Southeast corner of Lot 1311 and on the West side of "Road 8 West", the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 24461.5 feet South and 8613.7 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2650, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 355° 40' 900.0 feet along the West side of "Road 8 West" to an iron pipe;
2. 85° 40' 1936.0 feet along Lot 1412 to an iron pipe;
3. 175° 40' 900.0 feet along Lot 1313 to an iron pipe;
4. 265° 40' 1936.0 feet along Lots 1312 and 1311 to the point of beginning.

AREA 40 ACRES.

Excepting and reserving therefrom the Government Survey Trig. Station "Waiakea Mauka" and a lot 50 feet square surrounding same, (Area 06/100 Acre), together with the right to enter upon said lot and to occupy said Trig. Station;

Also, excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 20 feet wide for the railroad across this lot, said right-of-way containing an Area of 54/100 Acre;
