Beginning at an iron pipe at the Northwest corner of this lot, the Southeast side of "Road C", the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 26008.2 feet South and 13349.7 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2650, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 223° 25' 360.0 feet along the Southeast side of "Road C" to an iron pin;
2. 313° 25' 250.0 feet along camp site No. 10 to an iron pipe;
3. 223° 25' 180.0 feet along same to a + on rock;
4. 313° 25' 2157.6 feet along Lot 1414 to an iron pipe;
5. 43° 25' 900.0 feet along Lot 1512 to an iron pipe;
6. 133° 25' 2011.3 feet along government land to an iron pipe;
7. 175° 40' 535.4 feet along same to the point of beginning.

AREA 47-07/100 ACRES.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 10 feet wide for the flume across this lot, said right-of-way containing an Area of 10/100 Acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 46-97/100 ACRES.
