Beginning at a spike set in concrete at the Southwest corner of this lot, the Southeast corner of Lot 16, and on the North side of road (30 feet wide), the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kaneahuea" being 1692.6 feet North and 490.4 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2813, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 172° 07' 111.7 feet along Lot 16, to a spike set in concrete;
2. 271° 51' 71.0 feet along L.C.A. 9502 to Kekau to a spike set in concrete;
3. 352° 07' 99.7 feet along the West side of road (30 feet wide) to a spike set in concrete;
4. 82° 07' 70.0 feet along road (30 feet wide), to the point of beginning.
