Palolo Homesteads,
Waiomao, Palolo Valley, Kona, Oahu.

Beginning at \dagger on solid rock at angle in the South boundary of this lot and at the Northwest corner of Lot 15, the true azimuth and distance from said marked rock to Government Survey Trig. Station "Makanui" being $141^{\circ} 46'$ 377.5 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2293, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $60^{\circ} 51'$ 313.5 feet along Lot 15 to \dagger on set stone;
2. Thence along the East side of Palolo Valley 50 Foot Road, on a curve to the left having a radius of 136 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being: $163^{\circ} 15'$ 248.0 feet;
3. $97^{\circ} 50'$ 160.0 feet along North side of Palolo Valley Road;
4. $129^{\circ} 00'$ 3.0 feet along North side of Palolo Valley Road to \dagger on large rock near mango tree;
5. $235^{\circ} 21'$ 332.5 feet up spur along Lot 17 to "Makanui" Trig. Station (marked by \triangle on solid rock); from which the true azimuth and distance to "Paina 2" Trig. Station is $350^{\circ} 28' 30''$ 2198.9 feet, and to "Waiomao" Trig. Station is $28^{\circ} 43' 30''$ 1921.6 feet;
6. $230^{\circ} 26'$ 744.0 feet up spur along Lot 17 to \triangle on solid rock;
7. $326^{\circ} 52'$ 819.0 feet down pali along Lot 6 to \dagger on large rock in Waiomao Stream;
8. Thence down the center of Waiomao Stream, the direct azimuth and distance being: $47^{\circ} 12'$ 535.0 feet to a \triangle on solid rock in stream;

9. $124^{\circ} 57'$ 484.0 feet along Lot 15 to the point of beginning.

Excepting and reserving therefrom L.C.A. 1898, Apana 3 to Oponui, and portions of L.C. Awards 1898, Ap. 2 to Oponui and 3415B to Kaahui, leaving a net area of 15.0 ACRES.
