Beginning at an ohia post on the West side of Thrum's Trail (50 feet wide) adjoining the land of Kaueleau, the coordinates of said ohia post referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kaliu" being 506.7 feet South and 7979.7 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2424, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 46° 00' 2182.0 feet along Thrum's Trail;
2. 59° 50' 1159.0 feet along Thrum's Trail;
3. 139° 03' 1596.0 feet along Lot XIII;
4. 238° 45' 1050.0 feet along Government land of Kamaili;
5. 265° 00' 652.0 feet along Government land of Kamaili;
6. 226° 00' 982.0 feet along Government land of Kamaili;
7. 286° 00' 1419.0 feet along land of Kaueleau (as per Boundary Certificate No. 178) to the point of beginning.
