Beginning at a spike set in concrete at the Northwest corner of this lot, the Northeast corner of Lot 17, and on the South side of road (30 feet wide), the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kaneahuea" being 1662.9 feet North and 494.5 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2813, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 262° 07' 70.0 feet along road (30 feet wide), to a spike set in concrete;
2. 352° 07' 103.8 feet along West side of road (30 feet wide), to a spike set in concrete;
3. 84° 08' 70.0 feet along Government Land and along L.C.A. 205 Apana B to Kalua to a spike set in concrete;
4. 172° 07' 101.4 feet along Lot 17, to the point of beginning.
