Being a portion of Lot 15, Grant 6174 to William Henry of the Keaahala Homesteads, and a portion of Grant 9313 to F. James a portion of L.C.A. 5820:1 to Kapuniai, and a portion of L.C.A. 5822 to Koolau situated at Kaneohe, Oahu.

Beginning at a 3/4" galvanized iron pipe at the North-west corner of this lot, on the North-East side of a 20 foot road, the same being the South-West corner of Lot 16, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "Coolidge", being 503.0 feet South, 1092.3 feet West, and running by true azimuths from the above described initial point:

1. 266° 00' 163.0 feet along Lot 16 to a pipe;
2. 356° 00' 140.0 feet along Lots 24 and 36-D to a pipe;
3. 86° 00' 163.0 feet along Lot 18 to a pipe;
4. 176° 00' 140.0 feet along the East side of a 20 foot road to the point of beginning, and containing an area of 22,820 square feet.
