Being a portion of the Government (Crown) Land of Waimanalo

Beginning at the North corner of this lot, the West corner of Lot 177 and on the Southeast side of Ehukai Street, the direct azimuth and distance from an iron pipe at the North corner of Lot 175 being $58^{\circ} 00'$ 150.0 feet, and the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kailua" being 16106.68 feet South and 24879.82 feet East as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2675 and running by true azimuths:

1. $328^{\circ} 00'$ 150.0 feet along Lot 177;
2. $58^{\circ} 00'$ 75.0 feet along Lot 180;
3. $148^{\circ} 00'$ 150.0 feet along Lot 181;
4. $238^{\circ} 00'$ 75.0 feet along Ehukai Street to the point of beginning.
