Palolo Homesteads,  
Pukele, Palolo Valley, Kona, Oahu.

Beginning at Government Survey Trig. Station "Rocky Hollow" (marked by an inch pipe), at the Northeast corner of this lot on top of ridge being also the junction of the lands of Pukele, Waiomao and Kekio, from which the true azimuth and distance to Government Survey Trig. Station "Paina 2" is  $12^{\circ} 49' 30''$  4388.1 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2293, and running by true azimuths:-

1. Along top of ridge between Pukele and Waiomao along Lots 10, 9, 8, and 7 to "Peak" Trig. Station (marked by  $\ast$  on rock), the direct azimuth and distance being:  $21^{\circ} 18'$  1263.0 feet;
2.  $99^{\circ} 13'$  1086.0 feet along Lot 17, down pali across road and passing over  $\ast$  on rock in Pukele Stream and up pali to a chisel driven in the ground;
3.  $209^{\circ} 35'$  1309.0 feet along land of Wailupe to corner of fence;
4.  $275^{\circ} 12'$  239.4 feet down pali along Lot 19 to spikes in stream at water fall;
5.  $279^{\circ} 56'$  656.5 feet along ~~Lot 19~~ <sup>Wailupe</sup> and up pali to the point of beginning.

Excepting and reserving therefrom portions of the two 20 Foot Homestead Roads within this lot, leaving a net area of 26.8 ACRES.
