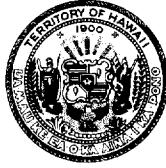

Kahauloa 1st, South Kona, Hawaii.

Beginning at the northwest corner of this parcel of land, the south corner of Lot 13, Kahauloa House Lots and on the east side of a 30 foot road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "Kaneahua" being 1568.66 feet North and 608.51 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map 2813, and running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1. 258° 12' 00" 173.70 feet along Lots 13 and 10, Kahauloa House Lots (Grant 10905 ~~to S. 2nd 10904~~ to Senichi Okimoto);
2. 68° 16' 30" 181.85 feet along L.C.Aw. 206-B to Kaoni;
3. 178° 02' 00" 31.81 feet along the east side of a 30 foot road to the point of beginning.
