
Beginning at a pipe at the Southeast corner of this lot, the Southwest corner of Lot 18, Waiakea Cane Lots and on the North side of Road 8, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 8336.4 feet South and 3856.4 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 85° 40' 714.0 feet along Road 8 to a pipe;
2. 175° 40' 1390.5 feet along Lot 20 to a pipe;
3. 252° 15' 734.1 feet along Lot 16 to a pipe;
4. 355° 40' 1560.8 feet along Lot 18 to the point of beginning.

AREA 24-19/100 ACRES.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way for the Waiakea Mill Company's railroad, as shown on plan hereto attached and made a part hereof, containing an area of 39/100 acre and LEAVING A NET AREA OF 22-60/100 ACRES of Cane land and 1-20/100 Acres of Waste Land.
