Beginning at  $\dagger$  on large solid rock at "Kapuuloa" between this lot and the land of Kekio on the Northeast side of Pukele Stream, the true azimuth and distance from said marked rock to Government Survey Trig. Station "Rocky Hollow" being  $294^{\circ} 18'$  798.4 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2293, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $339^{\circ} 20'$  230.0 feet along land of Kekio to spikes in stream at water fall;
2.  $95^{\circ} 12'$  239.4 feet along Lot 18 and up pali to fence corner;
3.  $136^{\circ} 06'$  1048.5 feet along land of Wailupe to  $\dagger$  on rock;
4.  $232^{\circ} 00'$  786.0 feet along Forest Reserve to koa tree;
5.  $296^{\circ} 06'$  611.0 feet along Lot 20 to  $\dagger$  on set stone;
6.  $20^{\circ} 05'$  827.0 feet along land of Kekio to the point of beginning.

Excepting and reserving therefrom that portion of the 20 Foot Homestead Road within this lot, leaving a net area of 18.0 ACRES.
