Beginning at an iron pipe at the West corner of this lot and on the East side of Government Main Road, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Coolidge" being 3095.1 feet South and 3800.3 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2562, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 234° 17' 1340.9 feet along Lot 20 to an iron pipe;
2. 316° 35' 330.0 feet along konohiki to an iron pipe;
3. 52° 34' 1560.5 feet, <sup>also</sup> the land of Puahuula to an iron pipe;
4. 169° 20' 412.6 feet along Government Main Road to the point of beginning.

Area 11-63/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom a right-of-way 10 feet wide for the ditch across this lot, said right-of-way containing an area of 8/100 acre; LEAVING A NET AREA OF 11-55/100 ACRES.
