Beginning at a red-wood post at the North corner of this lot and the junction of the Kawaiiloa and Popoia Roads, the coordinates of said red-wood post referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Mokapu" being: 21100.0 feet South and 1847.8 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2502, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 305° 39' 70.0 feet along Kawaiiloa Road to a stake;
2. 35° 39' 363.0 feet along Lot 22 to a stake;
3. 125° 39' 215.2 feet along the land of Kaelepulu to a galvanized iron pipe;
4. 245° 48' 289.1 feet along Popoia Road to a red-wood post;
5. 215° 39' 113.0 feet along Popoia Road to the point of beginning.
