Beginning at a stake at the North corner of this lot, the West corner of Lots 21 and 22, Part A, on the Southeast side of Aiea Ridge Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Salt Lake" being 9531.3 feet North and 1796.9 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2536, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $326^{\circ} 05'$  826.9 feet along Lots 21 and 22, Part A, to rocky pali, passing over a stake at 636.9 feet;
2. Thence along rocky pali, the direct azimuth and distance being:  $54^{\circ} 48'$  305.8 feet;
3. Thence along rocky pali to the East corner of Lot 25, the direct azimuth and distance being:  $74^{\circ} 27'$  341.9 feet;
4.  $146^{\circ} 05'$  787.1 feet along Lot 25, passing over a stake; at 250.0 feet;
5.  $247^{\circ} 14'$  313.1 feet along Southeast side of Aiea Ridge Road, to a stake;
6.  $242^{\circ} 38' 30''$  104.8 feet along same, to a stake;
7.  $236^{\circ} 31'$  158.4 feet along same, to a stake;
8.  $224^{\circ} 26'$  61.8 feet along same, to the point of beginning.
