1. 340° 00' 726.1 feet along Lot 27 to an iron pipe;
2. 90° 20' 913.1 feet along konohiki to a carriage axel;
3. 189° 33' 469.0 feet along Lot 34 to an iron pipe;
4. 250° 00' 625.0 feet along Homestead Road to the point of beginning.
