Being a portion of L.P. 8165, Part B, on a portion of L.C.Aw. 8559-B Apana 32 to William C. Lunaliilo

Being also portion of the land conveyed to the Minister of Interior by the Trustees of William C. Lunaliilo Estate by Deed dated June 17, 1884, and recorded in Liber 88 on Pages 223 and 224 (Land Office Deed 136), set aside as Fort Ruger Military Reservation, Tract 1, by Presidential Executive Order 6408, dated November 7, 1933 and subsequently restored to the possession, use and control of the Territory of Hawaii by Presidential Executive Order 10648 (Parcel 1) dated December 8, 1955.

Beginning at the southwest corner of this lot, the southeast corner of Lot 29, Diamond Head View Lots, Unit One, and on the north side of Diamond Head Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "LEAHI" being 266.67 feet South and 4495.78 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map 4090, thence running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1. 168° 51' 20" 6.00 feet along Lot 29, Diamond Head View Lots, Unit One;
2. 258° 51' 20" 6.00 feet along Lot 30-B, Diamond Head View Lots, Unit One;
3. 348° 51' 20" 6.00 feet along Lot 30-B, Diamond Head View Lots, Unit One;
4. 78° 51' 20" 6.00 feet along the north side of Diamond Head Road to the point of beginning and containing an Area of 36 Square Feet.
