RESERVING to the Territory of Hawaii for itself, the Hawaii Irrigation Authority or its successors, or any governmental agency or body having the power to create and operate irrigation projects for the reclamation, or improved economic use of public and private lands, to the extent and for such period of time any irrigation project, district or area hereafter established by the abovementioned Hawaii Irrigation Authority or its successors, or any governmental agency or body, continues to exist, the right to divert excess waters, at any time, from its Reservoir Ditch Right-of-Way into that portion of the stream which crosses said Lot 43.

RESERVING to the Territory of Hawaii in perpetuity the waters and all riparian and other rights in and to the stream which passes over and across the above described Lot 43 as shown on the plan attached hereto and made a part hereof.
