Waikaumalo-Maulua Homesteads,

North Hilo, Hawaii.

Beginning at the East corner of this lot at a point in Puu o Lii Gulch at mauka, <sup>side</sup> ~~edge~~ of Government Road, from which point Station 56 of the Waikaumalo-Maulua Traverse of Main Govt. Road is by true azimuth and distance  $281^{\circ} 00'$  75.0 feet, and the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu Ohai" are 4382.7 feet North and 631.0 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2812, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $117^{\circ} 12'$  195.1 feet along mauka, <sup>side</sup> ~~edge~~ of Government Road;
2.  $95^{\circ} 51'$  323.5 feet along mauka, <sup>side</sup> ~~edge~~ of Government Road;
3.  $15^{\circ} 50'$  562.0 feet along East side of Maulua Gulch to a post;
4.  $12^{\circ} 55'$  334.4 feet along East side of 30 foot road;
5.  $24^{\circ} 35'$  218.3 feet along East side of 30 foot road;
6.  $6^{\circ} 47'$  69.5 feet along East side of 30 foot road to a post near Puu o Lii Stream;
7. Thence along road (30 feet wide) to Puu o Lii Stream and down center of said stream along Lot 51 to a point in said stream, the direct azimuth and distance being:  $273^{\circ} 50'$  434.0 feet;
8. Thence continuing down center of said stream along Lot 51 to North corner of Lot 51, the direct azimuth and distance being:  $204^{\circ} 38'$  402.9 feet;
9. Thence continuing down center of said stream, <sup>along Lot 49</sup> to the point of beginning, the direct azimuth and distance being:  $198^{\circ} 15'$  710.1 feet;
