Beginning at an iron pipe at the Southeast corner of this lot and the Southwest ~~corner~~ of Lot 511-A, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 9825.1 feet South and 8566.8 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:

1. 85° 40' 484.0 feet along Camp Site No. 3 and Lot 611-B, to an iron pipe;
2. 175° 40' 1800.0 feet along Lot 512-A to an iron pipe;
3. 265° 40' 484.0 feet along the South side of "Road 8" to an iron pipe;
4. 355° 40' 1800.0 feet along Lot 511-A to the point of beginning.

AREA 20 ACRES.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 20 feet wide for the railroad across this lot, said right-of-way containing an Area of 30/100 Acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 19-70/100 ACRES.
