Beginning at an iron pipe at the Southwest corner of this lot and the Southeast corner of Lot 512-B, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 9898.2 feet South and 7601.5 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 175° 40' 1800.0 feet along Lot 512-B to an iron pipe;
2. 265° 40' 484.0 feet along the South side of "Road 8" to an iron pipe;
3. 355° 40' 1800.0 feet along Lot 511-B to an iron pipe;
4. 85° 40' 484.0 feet along Lot 612-A to the point of beginning.
