Beginning at an iron pipe at the Southeast corner of this lot and the Southwest corner of Lot 611-A, on the North side of "Road 10", the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 11659.8 feet South and 8705.8 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 85° 40' 484.0 feet along North side of "Road 10" to an iron pipe;
2. 175° 40' 1840.0 feet along Lot 612-A to an iron pipe;
3. 265° 40' 355.4 feet along Lot 511-B to an iron pipe;
4. 355° 40' 684.4 feet along Camp Site No. 3 to an iron pipe;
5. 265° 40' 128.6 feet along same to an iron pipe;
6. 355° 40' 1155.6 feet across railroad reserve and along Lot 611-A to the point of beginning.

Area 18-42/100 Acres.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 20 feet wide for the railroad across this lot, said right-of-way containing an Area of 74/100 Acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 17-68/100 ACRES.
