
Beginning at an iron pipe at the Northeast corner of this lot and the Northwest corner of Lot 617-A, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 10266.8 feet South and 2735.6 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 355° 40' 1840.0 feet along Lot 617-A to an iron pipe;
2. 85° 40' 484.0 feet along the North side of "Road 10" to an iron pipe;
3. 175° 40' 1840.0 feet along the East side of "Road 3 West" to an iron pipe;
4. 265° 40' 484.0 feet along Lot 517-B to the point of beginning.

Area 20-44/100 Acres.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 20 feet wide for the railroad across this lot, said right-of-way containing an Area of 23/100 Acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 20-21/100 ACRES.
