Beginning at an iron pipe at the Northwest corner of this lot and the Northeast corner of Lot 713-B, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 11847.3 feet South and 6758.4 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 265° 40' 504.0 feet along the South side of "Road 10" to an iron pipe;
2. 355° 40' 1800.0 feet along Lot 712-B to an iron pipe;
3. 85° 40' 504.0 feet along Lot 806-A to an iron pipe;
4. 175° 40' 1800.0 feet along Lot 713-B to the point of beginning.

Area 20-83/100 Acres.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 20 feet wide for the railroad across this lot, said right-of-way containing an Area of 23/100 Acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 20-60/100 ACRES.
