1. 265° 40' 484.0 feet along the South side of "Road 10" to an iron pipe;
2. 355° 40' 1800.0 feet along Lot 713-B to an iron pipe;
3. 85° 40' 484.0 feet along Lot 807-A to an iron pipe;
4. 175° 40' 1800.0 feet along Lot 714-B to the point of beginning.
