Beginning at an iron pipe at the Northwest corner of this lot and on the Northeast corner of Lot 715-B, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 11995.0 feet South and 4808.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 265° 40' 484.0 feet along the South side of "Road 10" to an iron pipe;
2. 355° 40' 1800.0 feet along Lot 714-B to an iron pipe;
3. 85° 40' 484.0 feet along Lot 808-A to an iron pipe;
4. 175° 40' 1800.0 feet along Lot 715-B to the point of beginning.

Area 20.00 Acres.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 40 feet wide for the road (56/100 Acre) and railroads (18/100 Acre) across this lot, being respectively 20 feet and 10 feet wide, said right-of-way containing an Area of 74/100 Acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 19-26/100 ACRES.
