Beginning at an iron pipe at the Northwest corner of this lot and the Northeast corner of Lot 716-B, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 12068.1 feet South and 3842.7 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 265° 40' 484.0 feet along the South side of "Road 10" to an iron pipe;
2. 355° 40' 1800.0 feet along Lot 715-B to an iron pipe;
3. 85° 40' 484.0 feet along Lot 809 to an iron pipe;
4. 175° 40' 1800.0 feet along Lot 716-B to the point of beginning.

Area 20.00 Acres.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 40 feet wide for the road (80/100 Acre) and the railroad (20/100 Acre) across this lot, being respectively 20 feet and 10 feet wide, said right-of-way containing an Area of 1.00 Acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 19-00/100 ACRES.
