Beginning at an iron pipe at the Northwest corner of this lot and the Northeast corner of Lot 717-B, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 12141.2 feet South and 2877.5 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 265° 40' 484.0 feet along South side of "Road 10" to an iron pipe;
2. 355° 40' 1401.7 feet along Lot 716-B; to an iron pipe;
3. 57° 31' 150.0 feet along camp site No. 4, Section A;
4. 355° 40' 197.6 feet along same;
5. 57° 31' 137.3 feet along North side of "Road A" to an iron pipe;
6. 175° 40' 153.4 feet along camp site No. 4, Section B, to an iron pipe;
7. 57° 31' 261.5 feet along same to an iron pipe;
8. 175° 40' 1705.2 feet along Lot 717-B to the point of beginning.
