Beginning at an iron pipe at the Northwest corner of this lot, the Northeast corner of Lot 723 and on the South side of "Road 10", the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 12547.0 feet South and 2471.2 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2650, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 265° 40' 968.0 feet along the South side of "Road 10" to an iron pipe;
2. 355° 40' 1800.0 feet along Lot 721 to an iron pipe;
3. 85° 40' 968.0 feet along Lot 816 to an iron pin in gulch;
4. 175° 40' 1800.0 feet along Lot 723 to the point of beginning.
