Beginning at the West corner of this lot and on the East side of Makiki Street, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Makiki" being 1163.12 feet South and 391.34 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2338, and running by true azimuths:-

- * 1. $197^{\circ} \overset{30'}{20'}$ 123.5 feet along Makiki Street;
- 2. Thence on a curve to the right with a radius of 80.0 feet and for a distance of 40.9 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being:- $212^{\circ} 08'$ 40.4 feet;
- 3. $313^{\circ} 35'$ 518.1 feet along Lot 803;
- 4. $72^{\circ} 00'$ 153.1 feet along fence along Judd Pasture;
- 5. $67^{\circ} 43'$ 17.4 feet along fence along Judd Pasture;
- 6. $133^{\circ} 35'$ 375.8 feet along Grant 5250 to Robert W. Shingle and Lot 801A to the point of beginning.
