Beginning at the Southeast corner of this lot and the Southwest corner of Lot 807-B on the North side of "Road 12", the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 15588.3 feet South and 5565.6 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 85° 40' 484.0 feet along North side of "Road 12" to an iron pipe;
2. 175° 40' 1840.0 feet along Lot 808-B to an iron pipe;
3. 265° 40' 484.0 feet along Lot 715-A to an iron pipe;
4. 355° 40' 1840.0 feet along Lot 807-B to the point of beginning.

Area 20-44/100 Acres.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 20 feet wide for the railroad across this lot, said right-of-way containing an Area of 22/100 Acres, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 20-22/100 ACRES.
