Beginning at an iron pipe at the South corner of this lot, the East corner of Lot 813 and on the Northwest side of "Road A", the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 15417.3 feet South and 1629.5 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2650, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 175° 40' 1972.0 feet along Lots 813 and 719 to an iron pipe;
2. 265° 40' 968.0 feet along Lot 718 to an iron pipe;
3. 355° 40' 944.5 feet along the West side of "Road 3 West" to an iron pipe;
4. 57° 17' -436.5 feet along the Northwest side of "Road A" to an iron pipe;
5. 41° 05' 178.8 feet along same to an iron pipe;
6. 28° 58' 831.9 feet along same to the point of beginning.

AREA 29-82/100 ACRES.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 20 feet wide for the railroad across this lot, said right-of-way containing an Area of 28/100 Acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 29-54/100 ACRES.
