Beginning at the Northwest corner of this lot and the Northeast corner of Lot 904, on the South side of "Road 12" the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 15405.7 feet South and 8504.2 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 265° 40' 1744.0 feet along South side of "Road 12" to an iron pipe;
2. 0° 33' 185.3 feet along West side of old Volcano Road to an iron pipe;
3. 355° 40' 269.1 feet along same to an iron pipe;
4. 343° 02' 457.5 feet along same to an iron pipe;
5. 85° 40' 1828.3 feet along Lot 902 to an iron pipe;
6. 175° 40' 900.0 feet along Lot 904 to the point of beginning.

Area 36-26/100 Acres.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 20 feet wide for the railroad across this lot, said right-of-way containing an Area of 45/100 Acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 35-81/100 ACRES.
