Beginning at an iron pipe at the Northwest corner of this lot and the Southwest corner of Lot 902, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 17200.6 feet South and 8640.2 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 265° 40' 2207.2 feet along Lot 902 to an iron pipe;
2. 28° 33' 102.2 feet along West side of old Volcano Road to an iron pipe;
3. 10° 40' 293.2 feet along same to an iron pipe;
4. 17° 51' 358.9 feet along same to an iron spike;
5. 341° 24' 205.0 feet along same to an iron pipe;
6. 85° 40' 1990.7 feet along government land to an iron pipe;
7. 175° 40' 900.0 feet along Lot 906 to the point of beginning.

Area 42-30/100 Acres.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 20 feet wide for the railroad across this lot, said right-of-way containing an Area of 49/100 Acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 41-81/100 ACRES.
