Kaimu Homesteads (Thrum's Subdivision)

Puna, Hawaii.

Beginning at the Southeast corner of this lot, from which point the true azimuth and distance is $270^{\circ} 00'$ 526.7 feet to a post and pile of stones at the Northeast corner of Lot 3 of the Kikala-Keokea Homesteads, and on the South side of the Upper Puna Road to Kalapana, and the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Hakuma" are 24558.6 feet North and 4647.6 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2191, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $20^{\circ} 51'$ 1003.6 feet along Lot 3 of the Kikala-Keokea Homesteads;
2. $111^{\circ} 35'$ 2343.0 feet along Government land;
3. $219^{\circ} 40'$ 2678.5 feet along Section D of Lot V and Lot IV of the
Kaimu Homesteads;
4. $337^{\circ} 30'$ 2155.0 feet along Government land to the point of
beginning.
