PARCEL 4-A, Kaneohe Ranch (owner)
Being a portion of the Ahupuaa of Kamakalepo
Kailua, Koolauloko, Oahu, T.H.

Beginning at the West corner of this piece, and on the Northwest side of the proposed Waimanalo Road, (50 feet wide), the true azimuth and distance to Station 110+95.75 of the center line of the proposed Waimanalo Road being $342^{\circ} 08' - 36.24$ feet and the co-ordinates of said Station (110+95.75) referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "KAILUA" being 2804.19 feet South and 3841.71 feet East and running by true azimuths from the above described initial point:-

1. Firstly on a curve to the right, having a radius of 525 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being $224^{\circ} 24' 33'' - 311.10$ feet;
2. $26^{\circ} 10' - 33.00$ feet along L.C.A. 6813, ap. 1 to Keliikanakaole;
3. $52^{\circ} 46' - 133.50$ feet along the Northwest side of Old Government road (30 feet wide);
4. $38^{\circ} 55' - 164.00$ feet along same;
5. $26^{\circ} 50' - 25.00$ feet along same;
6. $162^{\circ} 08' - 21.00$ feet along the Kailua Uka School Lot to the point of beginning and containing an area of 0.15 Acres.

Beginning at the South corner of this piece, and on the Southeast side of the proposed Waimanalo Road, (50 feet wide) the true azimuth and distance to Station 110+95.75 of the center line of the proposed Waimanalo Road being $162^{\circ} 08' - 38.56$ feet and the co-ordinates of said Station (110+95.75) referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "KAILUA" being 2304.19 feet South and 3841.71 feet East and running by true azimuths from the above described initial point:-

1. $162^{\circ} 08' - 11.40$ feet along the Kailua Uka School Lot;
2. $206^{\circ} 50' - 59.00$ feet along the Southeast side of Old Government Road (30 feet wide);
3. $218^{\circ} 55' - 34.50$ feet along same;
4. Thence on a curve to the left, having a radius of 475 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being $26^{\circ} 20' - 91.90$ feet to the point of beginning and containing an area of 0.01 Acres.

Beginning at the Northeast corner of this piece, and on the North side of the proposed Waimanalo Road, (50 feet wide), the true azimuth and distance to Station 117+33.78 of the center line of the proposed Waimanalo Road being $7^{\circ} 21' - 25.00$ feet and the co-ordinates of said Station (117+33.78) referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "KAILUA" being 2513.54 feet South and 4361.57 feet East and running by true azimuths from the above described initial point:-

1. $7^{\circ} 21' - 16.00$ feet along the remainder of Grant 2891 ap. 3 to W. E. Pii;
2. $94^{\circ} 42' - 115.00$ feet along the North side of Old Government Road (30 feet wide);
3. $155^{\circ} 03' - 8.93$ feet along the remainder of L.C.A. 6813 ap. 1 to Keliikanakaole;
4. Thence on a curve to the right, having a radius of 525 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being $270^{\circ} 45' 30'' - 120.40$ feet to the point of beginning and containing an area of 0.04 Acres.
