Description of the center line of proposed

Situated at Kaneohe, Keolaupoko, Oahu,

Beginning at the east end of this piece of land on the center line (40.0 feet wide) and on the boundary between the lands of Mikila and ~~Keana~~ ^{Keana}, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "Mokapu" being 15,769.04 feet south and 15,250.68 feet west, and running by true azimuths:

1. 82° 48' 301.58 feet;
2. thence on a curve to the left with a radius of 500.0 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being 65° 47' 30" 295.01 feet; 38
3. 48° 29' 1359.65 feet;
4. thence on a curve to the left with a radius of 500.0 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being 33° 29' 258.82 feet;
5. 18° 29' 263.60 feet;
6. thence on a curve to the right with a radius of 300.0 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being 50° 20' 30" 316.69 feet;
7. 82° 12' 45.00 feet to the boundary between the lands of ~~Keana~~ ^{Keana} and Puahuula and containing an area of 2.630 acres.
