Beginning at a + on solid rock on rocky point on the South line of this lot and the boundary of the KEAAU-MAKUA FOREST RESERVE, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kepuhi" being 9192.6 feet North and 1204.4 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2408, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 99° 06' 546.7 feet along Lot 7 to 1½ inch pipe on the South side of 40 foot road;
2. 149° 46' 40.04 feet across road to 1½ inch pipe in clump of rocks at the Southeast corner of L.C.A. 5736 to Kihi;
3. 180° 23' 365.0 feet along L.C.A. 5736 to Kihi to 1½ inch pipe;
4. 171° 27' 496.6 feet along L.C.A. 5739:1 to Kanaue and L.C.A. 5967 to Muki, to 1 inch pipe;
5. 243° 30' 85.9 feet along L.C.A. 6044 to Ainoa to 1 inch pipe;
6. 186° 08' 144.5 feet along same to 1 inch pipe;
7. 186° 08' 37.7 feet along Lot 6 to 1 inch pipe at fence;
8. 257° 27' 1121.0 feet along fence along land of Ohikilolo;
9. 295° 50' 421.0 feet along same to 1½ inch pipe;
10. 63° 32' 150.0 feet up slope and across road to a stake at top edge of gully;
11. 37° 32' 282.0 feet along near top edge of slope to a stake;

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12. 353° 43' 406.0 feet along near top edge of slope crossing small gully to a stake on the North side of main gulch;
13. 280° 52' 314.5 feet along near top edge of main gulch to the West boundary of Lot 4;
14. 356° 25' 848.0 feet along Lot 4 to 1½ inch pipe;
15. 108° 16' 1094.0 feet along KEAAU-MAKUA FOREST RESERVE to the point of beginning.
