2. <u>Term of Contract</u> . This Contract starts on and ends

3. <u>Compensation</u> . The CONTRACTOR shall be compensated for services				
rendered and costs incurred under this Contract for a total not to exceed

4. <u>Relationship of Parties</u> . The CONTRACTOR be				
compensated through the STATE's payroll system and employment taxes withheld.				
Notwithstanding the fact that the CONTRACTOR may be compensated through the STATE's				
payroll system and employment taxes are withheld and remitted to the appropriate tax				
jurisdiction, the CONTRACTOR shall not be considered to be an employee of the STATE in the				
provision of services under this Contract. Further, the CONTRACTOR shall not be entitled to				
claim or receive from the STATE any vacation, sick leave, retirement, or other benefits provided				
to state employees.				
5. Other Terms and Conditions. The General Conditions and any Special				
Provisions are attached hereto and made a part of this Contract. In the event of a conflict				
between the General Conditions and the Special Provisions, the Special Provisions shall control.
