

General Public Information for Lei Draping Ceremony:

- Check in at Lei Check-In table, adjacent to the HFD firetruck
- Lei to be delivered to statue between 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. to Ali'iōlani Hale
 - 2:30 pm – 3:00 pm Royal Hawaiian Band Performs
 - 3:00 pm – 4:00 pm Formal Program
- Once Lei Draping Ceremony begins, lei will be grouped and draped at the discretion of the KKCC appointee, with the assistance of the Honolulu Fire Department.
- Please label lei so emcee can make the necessary acknowledgements
 - Only the following to formally present lei at 3:00 pm:
 - King Kamehameha Celebration Commission
 - Hawaiian Benevolent Societies
 - Royal Order of Kamehameha I
 - 'Ahahui Ka'ahumanu
 - Hale O Nā Ali'i
 - Daughters & Sons of Hawaiian Warriors, Māmakakaua
 - Daughters of Hawai'i
 - Hawai'i Congressional delegates
 - Governor, State of Hawai'i
 - Mayor, City & County of Honolulu
 - Mayors present from other Hawai'i counties
 - All elected officials to be present, no proxy
 - All others invited to present ho'okupu immediately after, during Formal Program
 - Floral arrangements and bouquets welcome, but no food items or candles
- Those wanting to present oli, will be able to do so at a designated time during the overall program, but not in conjunction with their lei, unless part of one of the groups above
- Lei to be approximately 30 feet in length
 - Only natural plant materials to be used
 - Thread, string and kukui nuts are allowed
